This gun represents one weapon transferred to Israeli settlers in the occupied West Bank since October 7, 2023.

2,349 guns fit on this slide.

Over 150,000 guns and weapons have been transferred to Israeli settlers since October 7, 2023.

Showing them all would take 64 slides like this one.

Before October 7, 2023, Israeli citizens held 150,000 gun licenses. In the five months after October 7, the Israeli Ministry of National Security approved licenses for an additional

### 100,000 GUNS.

After October 7, the Israeli Ministry of National Security greatly relaxed the process for acquiring gun licenses. Even before October, individual gun licenses were only available to Israeli citizens who speak Hebrew and had served in Israel's military.

Many of these new licenses are held by Israeli settlers living in the occupied West Bank, in violation of international law. In 2023, illegal Israeli settlements accounted for

locations with the highest rates of Israeli gun ownership. West Bank settlers are estimated to be in possession of up to 165,000 firearms.





Additionally, since October 7 **the Israeli military has transferred over** 

### 150,000 MILITARY GRADE WEAPONS

like machine guns and semi-automatic rifles to Israeli settlers and militias, including settlement police and kitat konenut ("rapid response teams").

Armed settler militias intentionally blur the distinction between Israeli settlers and soldiers in the West Bank. In dozens of instances, Israeli settlers have been documented wearing Israeli military uniforms and harassing Palestinians. Increasingly, Israeli settlers gain access to equipment by joining police forces or militias operating in illegal Israeli settlements.

Recent Knesset legislation has even extended government benefits such as daily salaries to members of these militias. Before October 7, there were 89 such militias. Since then, over

### 800 MILITIAS HAVE FORMED

in illegal Israeli settlements in the West Bank or in Israeli localities near the West Bank or Gaza.





including killings, harassment, home raids, theft, and property destruction. Israeli settlers attacked at least 93 Palestinian communities, displaced 18 communities, killed at least 10 Palestinians and injured over 235 from October 2023-June 2024.

Israeli settlers commit acts of violence with near-total impunity. Between October-December 2023, **only two Israeli settlers were arrested and** 

## ZERO WERE INDICTED.

In 93.7% of open investigations of Israeli settler violence against Palestinians in the West Bank from 2005-2023, Israeli police closed the case without filing any charges.



### CASE STUDY: THE QUSRA MASSACRE

On October 9, 2023, Israeli settlers threatened Palestinian villagers with a "day of revenge." Two days later, settlers shot and killed 4 people in the Palestinian village of Qusra. Israeli soldiers were present and did nothing to stop the settlers. Later that day, Israeli soldiers confiscated evidence from a Palestinian private residence. At the funeral the next day, Israeli settlers shot and killed a father and son. No one was indicted.

### ISRAEL IMPORTS 98% OF ITS GUNS.

Israel imported 10,000 handguns from the United States in 2022 and 43,000 in 2023. In October 2023, Israel ordered over 13,000 rifles from U.S. gun makers. 99% of Israel's weapons imports come from the United States (69%) and Germany (30%).

While Israeli forces use U.S.-made weapons to commit genocide in Gaza, Israeli settlers are using U.S.-made guns and ammunition to attack Palestinians in the West Bank and expand illegal Israeli settlements.
