- **Tuesday September 8** People Against Genocide break into the British headquarters of FANUC, a supplier of industrial robots for Israeli weaponry assembly lines. The firm supplies robots to Elbit for constant production of tank and artillery shells, used by Israeli forces to commit genocide. [Aftershock](#)

The death toll from Israeli attacks on Lebanon since October 8, 2023, has reached 8,950 martyrs and 30,642 injured, according to the Lebanese Ministry of Public Health's Emergency Operations Center.

This includes 4,383 deaths and 12,406 injuries recorded since March 2. Meanwhile, Israeli airstrikes continued to hit southern towns, including Al-Mansouri, Marjayoun, and Nabatieh El Fawqa. [Fana](#)

Repairs to Saudi Arabia's East-West oil pipeline will take far longer than a month due to a lack of spare parts, with the pumping infrastructure catastrophically damaged and at least 8 locations on the pipe hit. That leaves Saudi Arabia set to run out of crude oil stocks for export within five to seven days, taking around 4 million barrels per day, ~4% of global supply, off the market, per three industry sources to Reuters. Some repaired points were struck again, using up the spares and undoing the work. Yanbu has about a week of stocks left on the kingdom's only export route that does not pass through Hormuz. Higher education, cognitive surrender and Palestine

Last August 13, MIT's Ad Hoc Committee on AI Use in Teaching, Learning, and Research Training issued a [report](#) on "the role of generative AI in the life and educational mission of the Institute," in order to "recommend how to navigate its challenges and opportunities." It begins with this sentence: "This report is a call to action."

[Alex Veremeyenko](#): "MIT published a brutally honest report on what AI is doing to students. A committee of professors and students spent five months studying how AI changed learning on campus, and the findings read like a warning to every university on the planet. Study groups are disappearing. Office hours are emptying out. Problem sets and take-home exams no longer prove

anything, because AI can produce credible solutions to almost any written assignment in the undergraduate curriculum. Students who lean on chatbots lose mastery and confidence, and some slip into what the report calls cognitive surrender, reaching for AI at the first hint of struggle.”

“The report calls AI detectors unreliable, says lockdown browsers feel like spying, and warns that policing students builds a classroom atmosphere of mutual distrust. **Instead, MIT wants to rebuild education around the things AI can't replace.** That means oral exams, semester portfolios, in-person project work, and a required social component in every subject. The report even floats the idea of rethinking grades entirely, since without a GPA to optimize, much of the incentive to cheat with AI evaporates. The committee warns professors against replacing undergrad research assistants with AI agents just because they're cheaper, because a university exists to grow people, not output. The most famous tech school on earth admitted the machines broke its way of teaching. Its answer is more humans, not more software.”

For us of Sarah Lawrence FSJP, the changes MIT is recommending sound a lot like the educational values of a Sarah Lawrence that is disappearing. For us it makes sad sense that the technological transformations to which MIT is responding correspond with a shift in values permitting previously unacceptable things: like disciplining campus political protest; like cooperating with federal pressures to persecute members of our community; like treating the confrontation with genocide as less important than protecting the feelings of those allied with its perpetrator, letting business as usual proceed. This is our community's version of cognitive surrender: instead of tangling with the reality of Israeli genocide and our complicity in it, we've defaulted to collusion with unjust power.

When the events of October 7 found our campus, we were hosting the Being Human series of speakers on AI. A month into the Israeli genocide against Palestine, we hosted trustee Phil Wiser, Chief Tech Officer of Paramount, ("Paramount under fire for meddling in Gaza coverage after '60 Minutes' producer resigns," [Middle East Eye](#)). His talk was called "Unleashing Creative Potential: Exploring AI's impact on Human Creativity at the Intersection of Media and Technology." At that same intersection, thousands of people in Palestine were already being murdered.

By the following April, thousands more had been killed, as we hosted Brian Christian—who when asked the vital question, "Who benefits and how?" spoke about the "strange palimpsest" of the corporate systems developing and profiting from AI layered over the lives of the workers they exploit, in Bangladesh or the Philippines, making one or two dollars an hour. "You know these sort of anonymized people," Christian said, "in developing countries."

We of SL FSJP are thinking about the strange palimpsest formed by AI and propaganda, as interwoven ways for power to manipulate meaning, down to the very meaning of what life is—as James Baldwin put it, "The civilized have created the wretched, quite coldly and deliberately, and do not intend to change the status quo; are responsible for their slaughter and enslavement; rain down bombs on

defenseless children whenever and wherever they decide that their 'vital interests' are menaced, and think nothing of torturing a man to death: these people are not to be taken seriously when they speak of the 'sanctity' of human life, or the 'conscience' of the civilized world." ("The Devil Finds Work") Our campus is not one on which the murder of "these sort of anonymized people" is celebrated—but it's one on which their lives are treated with the casual carelessness and disregard reflected in Christian's language, in a context framed not by the shared necessity of preventing genocide but by the prerogatives of its perpetrators.

In June of 2023, our president participated in the Yale School of Management's Chief Executive Leadership [Institute](#), on a panel called "AI - Aye Yai Yai: Perspectives of Pioneers." At the top of the program was OpenAI CEO Sam Altman, a week after the office of Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu tweeted, "Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu spoke today by telephone with OpenAI CEO Sam Altman. They discussed the opportunities and challenges facing the world and the State of Israel regarding artificial intelligence as well as cooperation with Israel in order to develop the field." The other speakers ranged from the President of Sarah Lawrence to the former President of the Ford Motor Company, the fourth Secretary of Homeland Security, the contra-war-era Ambassador to Honduras John Negroponte ("To this day, I do not believe that death squads were operating in Honduras"). The five sponsor logos of the "Leadership Partners" included two with branches in Israel, one that appears in the UN Special Rapporteur's 2025 [report](#) "From economy of occupation to economy of genocide," and Jared Kushner's law firm. There's a quote from Peter Thiel's co-pilot Max Revchin: "Think of AI as a human co-pilot helping both the customer service rep and the human find a very quick alignment on what it is they're trying to accomplish together." Levchin said in an [interview](#) last June, "The best recipe we've discovered, as humanity, is capitalism, a force for constant creative destruction where you build the next thing better than the other guy."

"Higher education must be in front of this, observed Cristle Collins Judd, president of Sarah Lawrence College," the program reports, "leveraging technology, as opposed to fighting it," someone else suggests, the strategy our college and others chose when attacked by the House Committee on the Workforce. It's our sense that that will prove not be our moment's most effective strategy, and that higher education might find ways to be in front of the worldwide movement to defend the Palestinian people against Israeli genocide as well.

The work we do at Sarah Lawrence has never been more important: to respect and foster unmanipulated learning, so students may learn to think for themselves. AI is one threat to this work's foundations; federal pressure to conform with imperial foreign policy objectives is another; propaganda is another. Particularly pernicious is the propaganda designed to normalize genocide: the repeated messages that some lives are more worthy of protection than others, that not all people are people, that business as usual must continue, that anyone who disagrees with this must be criticized at best and at worst disappeared. We're hoping that we as a community might find ways to defend the

work to which the College has been committed from its inception—to celebrate a 100th birthday not with platitudes and evasions and equivocations, but with the kind of clarity and courage students in the United States have demonstrated in response to the genocide since it began. They’ve refused many different kinds of surrender: cognitive, political, bureaucratic, social, legal, moral. Let’s stand beside them, and let their calls for action be ones we don’t discipline or ignore. Let’s rebuild our educational community around the values surrender to state power can’t replace. Let’s discover another recipe.

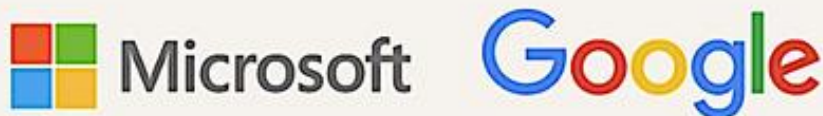
